

After experiencing vision problems for the past 2 1/2 yrs, I was referred to Dr. Shawn Cohen by the third optician that had tested my vision. That optician was able to diagnose my problem. He found that I had cataracts in both eyes.

I had the final cataract removed Jan. 23, 2014 and everything was successful. I cannot fully describe the changes it made in my life within the first 24 hrs.

I have no more double vision. I can now read the street signs and the house numbers from the street. I also relax as I read newspapers and books. Colors are more vivid. I find that my surroundings are much brighter. I can also tell the difference between my black and navy blue clothes! But the biggest improvement in my quality of life is that I no longer have the balance problems that I have been dealing with for the past two years. I stand straighter, walk with a solid step, and now have my natural walking gait. The surgeries have given me my life back.

I owe it all to Dr. Cohen, his staff at the Drummond Eye Clinic, and the staff in the operating room at the Montreal General Hospital. I will always be grateful for what they have done and the kindness and caring they have extended to me during all my visits. They calmed my nerves and my fears. They all helped me to build confidence in the procedures.
